MAPA (6.5h + 6.5h)	Saturday 25 <sup>th</sup> & Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> March in Guildford	An advanced Behaviour Management course offering detailed theory and practical skills on understanding behaviour, preventing escalation of aggression and how to apply physical interventions when required.	You must have attended Behaviour Management course before MAPA.
Moving People (5.5h)	Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> March in Farnham	How to move and support children and young people with limited mobility with different equipment (hoists, sliding sheets) and in different environments.	You must have completed the Manual Handling Online course.
Behaviour Management (3.5h)	Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> March in Farnham (2x sessions)	Understanding behaviour of children and young people in the schemes, what is acceptable and strategies to deal with challenging behaviour.	You should attend New Recruit course before or close to Behaviour Management

Minibus Escorts (2.5h)	Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> March in Farnham	This externally provided course focuses on escorting children and young people safely in minibuses, including emergency evacuation and securing a wheelchair in a minibus.	Only needed if you work in Youth or YA schemes, or escort children in minibuses
Fire Marshal (3h)	Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> March in Farnham	This external course offers theory and practical skills relating to Fire Safety. It will qualify you to be a Fire Marshal on scheme.	You must have attended all basic level courses.
Safeguarding refresher (2.5h)	Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> March in Guildford	Advanced workshop covering various aspects of safeguarding, including vulnerability of disabled children and child sexuality.	You must have attended New Recruit course before.
Moving People refresher (3h)	Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> March in Guildford	Reviewing how to move and support children and young people with limited mobility with different equipment (hoists, sliding sheets) and in different environments.	You must have attended a full Moving People course before.
Gastrostomy (2.5h)	Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> March in Guildford	Assisting a child or young person with a gastrostomy feeding tube. You must attend (or have attended) a Basic Life Support course alongside this course.	You must have attended Basic Life Support before this course. You will need to fill in a workbook and demonstrate skills before becoming competent to practice.
Basic Life Support (3h)	Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> March in Guildford	A basic overview of primary first aid, medical awareness and medication witnessing. You will need to attend this course before other medical courses!	You should have attended all other foundation and intermediate courses.
Paediatric First Aid (6.5h + 6.5h)	Saturday 22 <sup>nd</sup> & Sunday 23 <sup>rd</sup> April	The course gives an advanced overview of primary first aid and advanced medical procedures for children and young people. It will qualify you to be a First Aider on scheme.	You should have attended all other foundation and intermediate courses.
